PREFACE

The data presented in this publication were developed by the Joint Committee on Long-Term Care Alternatives in its study of the elderly population of Texas and the effectiveness of various services in meeting the needs of that population. Selected population figures from that study were further compiled into Senatorial and Representative districts to serve as a reference to individual legislative members when considering the problems and needs of the Texas elderly.

The population figures are based on county data compiled from the 1970 census, with the projections for 1980 and 2000 taking into account such variables as mortality rates and migration patterns. It is felt that they represent as accurate a picture, on the whole, as is currently possible. In referring to these data, however, the reader should bear two things in mind:

1. While it is relatively simple to project, within limits, changes in large populations, it becomes increasingly difficult as the numbers decrease to smaller units. Therefore the margin of error is increased when considering individual county figures, especially among the less populated counties.
2. As the data were compiled on a county basis, it was not possible to divide individual county figures along district lines. Therefore, when a district encompasses any portion of a county, the entire population of that county is included in the district totals. In these cases each legislator should estimate the proportion of a county's population that he or she represents and adjust the district figures accordingly.

A further note of explanation is needed regarding the service population and cost figures presented for each district.

The number of nursing home patients reflects the total number of individuals who resided in a nursing facility during FY 1978. It does not represent the average number of patients who would be found at any one time. On a statewide average, that number would be approximately 75 percent of the figure shown. The cost figures are exact, and are based on the total number of nursing care patients during FY 1978.

Over 96,000 individuals received community care service at some time during FY 1978, resulting in a monthly average

caseload of approximately 37,000 in-home clients. The figures shown reflect each district's proportionate share of the monthly average, based on the total number of clients served during the year. These figures represent only those persons receiving in-home services through the CCABD (Community Care for the Aged, Blind, and Disabled) Program of the Texas Department of Human Resources, and do not include other services of the Department or other agencies.
