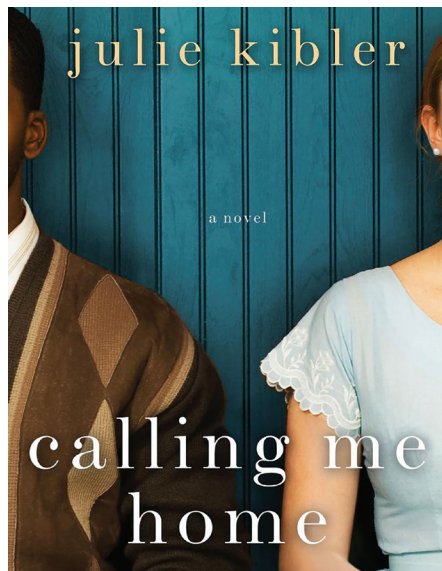


Focus on Faculty: Traci Freling
