Paul V. Chaplo, Marfa Flights: Aerial Views of Big Bend Country



Flying from Marfa, and hanging precariously from the open door of an aircraft, Chaplo shares a hawk's eye view of a fiercely beautiful region, revealing the stark and magnificent landscapes carved by the force of wind and water on the arid, mountainous country along the Rio Grande.
